Bandits kill vigilante, abduct over 10 people in Niger

SUSPECTED bandits have attacked Ebbo community in Lapal Local Government Area of Niger State, during which a vigilante official was killed and over 10 people abducted.

The hoodlums were also said to have razed some villages such as Angwan Dajin Gomna in Kpada community, where five persons were abducted,

as well as Zago and Lafiyan Zago villages.

An eyewitness said the bandits operated for more than six hours in the villages.

A community leader, Ismaila Saba Favu, while speaking with the Nigerian Tribune on phone on Thursday in Minna, called on government at all levels to urgently take steps to end the menace of banditry in the council area.
