

Police parade four suspects for killing filling station manager in Osun

① FOUR suspected armed robbers were on Thursday paraded by the Osun State Police Command for robbing and killing of one Fatai Atanda Adigun, a Mobil filling station manager in Ikire of Irewole Local Government Area of the state.

The suspects names were given as Adamo Aliyu'm' (24 years old), Damilola Kayode'm' (22 years old), Yusuf Idiris'm' (22 years old), Odewumi Sodiq'm' (26 years

old), and Adeshina Ayomide'm' (38 years old).

Adamo who revealed that, his parents died while he was at a tender age of six, said he had no option then, than to carry out manual works for survival.

He stated that he was an Indian hemp smoker and that he had lost count on the number of motorcycles

he had stolen from residents of the community and its environs.

The suspect further said that many okada riders lives were terminated due to their stubbornness and resistance when their motorcycles were about to be snatched away from them.

According to him, he has been making use of gun to rob his victims as early as the age of 12, and that, he had made about N1.5million so far in his robbery activities.

Adamo stated that he pur-

chased his gun at N12,000.

Speaking on the incident, the state Police Public Relations Officer, Mrs Yemisi Opolola explained that, "Upon a distress call/ intelligence on September 3, informing them of a robbery attack at Koteyemu/Aku area of Ikire, the police from Ikire Area Command in joint operation with the Civilian Joint Task Security Service, swiftly moved to the area and arrested a suspected notorious armed robber, one Adamo Aliyu having robbed his victim."
