

Wife dies in car accident after chasing husband with suspected side chick in C'River

A yet-to-be identified woman was involved in a car accident on Sunday evening in Calabar, Cross River State while allegedly chasing her husband on the highway.

The lady was said to have died minutes after being rushed to a hospital.

Eyewitnesses said the lady had spotted her husband at a shopping mall in Calabar with another woman who she suspected was dating her husband and decided to go after them.

Sources said when the husband rushed into his car with the other lady and zoomed off, the woman also rushed into her car and went after them.

It was gathered that in an attempt to double-cross her husband's car, the woman's car sped off the highway and crashed.

An eyewitness who identified himself as Steven Okposin explained that: "The lady saw her husband at a shopping mall with another woman in the car, so she hurriedly drove to double-cross them.

"The husband saw her car and zoomed off, so the woman became aggressive and followed them.

"I was just driving behind them, and in less than three minutes, I saw her involved in the accident and she was unconscious.

"The husband, who was running, suddenly dropped off the lady who was with him and went to assist to re-

trieve his wife from the car.

"She has been rushed to the hospital. We pray she survives it."

Minutes later, the lady was confirmed dead due to the injuries she sustained from the crash.

The sector commander of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) in the state, Maikano Hassan, confirmed the incident.

Hassan said the incident was caused by over-speeding.

"Though the woman was immediately rushed to a nearby hospital, she died minutes later due to the injuries she sustained from the accident."

The incident immediately sparked reactions on social media, with several ladies blaming the husband for his wife's death.
