

Three killed, seven injured as two BRT buses collide in Lagos

HREE persons were
on Wednesday
killed and seven
others injured following an accident
that occurred at Ketu area of
Lagos State.

Two red Bus Rapid Transport buses, popularly known as BRT, were attempting to overtake each other when the accident occurred at Alapere area of Ketu.

The Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) in the state confirmed the incident to the Nigerian Tribune, just as it added that it involved three vehicles.

It was gathered that the dead passengers were two

males and a female.

The early Wednesday accident created traffic on the Ikorodu expressway as the affected vehicles blocked a section of the road before they were evacuated.

The accident was, however, said to have occurred as a result of brake failure from one of the buses.

Apart from the two BRT buses, a commercial bus was also affected.

The state sector commander of the FRSC, Olusegun Ogungbemide, confirmed the incident to the **Nigerian Tribune**.

The FRSC boss added that the accident occurred at about 7:25a.m.
