

# Gunmen kill staff member of FCAH in Ibadan

**G**UNMEN have shot dead a middle-aged woman, Mrs Adeola Oyenike, while returning from her store at the popular Alesinloye market in

Ibadan South-West Local Government Area of Oyo State.

The deceased, aside from being a trader, was also identified as a staff member of the Federal College of Animal Health, Moore Plantation in Ibadan.

It was gathered that the deceased was trailed by the

gunmen to the point where she was waylaid and shot at several times at Aba Nla area of Ologuneru in Ido Local Government Area.

The door of her car, according to an eyewitness, was flung open while the gunmen shot at her.

The deceased, as reliably informed, died on the spot, while the gunmen escaped with her phones, leaving other valuables intact in the car.

The incident has thrown the entire neighbourhood of Ologuneru into mourning, as a similar incident occurred in the area

about three months ago.

A woman, who was identified as Aunt Dupe, was shot dead by gunmen at Agbala Iyanu area in September.

This development has made residents to become apprehensive over the activities of gunmen in the area.

When contacted, the state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Adewale Osifeso, said "the matter is being investigated."

He said: "The incident is under investigation; updates will be provided accordingly, please."
