

Bandits kill one, abduct 45 in Kaduna on Christmas Day

BANDITS on Christmas Day stormed Anguwar Aku village in Kajuru Local Government Area of Kaduna State and killed one person, just as they abducted 45 people. It was gathered that

the hoodlums came to the community at about 10:00a.m. when residents were about going to church.

The hoodlums, who arrived in the community on motorcycles, stationed themselves at strategic locations, while some hid in the bush and began to shoot sporadically.

According to a resident, the bandits went from house to house asking people to come out of their houses.

The source said: "We could not go to church because of the attack nor celebrate Christmas.

"Many people have also left the village to neighbouring towns and villages

because of fear of further attacks.

"At the end of the day when the stormed had settled, 45 people were kidnapped and taken away by the attackers."

As of the time of filing this report, the police and the state government were yet to react to the incident.
