The state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), SP Chris Anyanwu, confirmed the incident in a telephone conversation with newsmen.

The incident, it was learnt. occurred at Ekoli-Edda community on Monday.

The source, who could not confirm who started the

crisis, said it was reported including a vehicle belonging that youths loyal to one of the rivals arrived at the market square in the area in the company of their boss and shot sporadically into the air. which then attracted youths loval to the other person. who engaged them in a gun duel.

> The incident, it was learnt. occurred at about 6:00p.m., on Monday.

Speaking further, the source said: "At about 10:00p.m.,

unidentified stormed the country home of Chief Okoro-Emegha and set it ablaze."

The party chairman confirmed the burning of his house.

He said the gunmen attacked him and his convoy unprovoked, killing a Special Protection Unit (SPU) policeman attached to him.

He said two other persons from the village were also killed. Meanwhile, efforts to get

the reaction of Chief Chima failed as he did not answer calls made to his phones.

Following the clash, Governor David Umahi has ordered for the immediate arrest and prosecution of the

According to the Special Assistant to Governor Umahi on Media and Strategy, Chooks Oko, the governor gave the directive during an on-thespot assessment of the level of damage in the area.
