

Three killed, seven injured in Ogun road accident

THREE persons, two adults and a child, died on Thursday in an accident which occurred on the Abeokuta-Lagos Expressway. Seven other persons sustained injuries in the accident.

A statement made available to *Saturday Tribune* by the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) Education Officer for Ogun State, Florence Okpe, said the accident, which involved a *Toyota Camry* and a taxi cab, happened in the early hours of the day.

The accident was attributed to excessive speeding on the part of the driver of the *Toyota* car who rammed into the cab from behind.

Okpe explained that those injured were taken to a nearby hospital while the bodies of the dead were deposited

at the Federal Medical Centre (FMC), Abeokuta.

Sector commander of the FRSC, Ahmed Umar, advised motorists to obey traffic rules and regulations.

He advised against indiscriminate parking on the road because of the danger involved.
