

Mother of four stabbed to death in Ondo

A middle-aged mother of four, identified as Patience, has been stabbed to death on Oda road, in Akure, the Ondo State capital, by unknown persons.

The deceased, who was a hairdresser at popular Oja Oba market, was said to be on her way home from Kajola area when she was attacked in her car and stabbed by some persons at about 8:30p.m.

A source explained that the mother of four, who had gone for a business transaction, was driving home when the hoodlums attacked her, leaving her in her pool of blood, while her nipples were removed.

The source said the assailants had been trailing the hairdresser before attacking her at Kajola junction, adding that she gave up the ghost on the spot before help could reach her, while men of the Amotekun Corps in the area tried to chase the assailants.

"The victim was from Delta State; she was trailed to Kajola junction where she was attacked, stabbed and killed.

"We cannot fathom the reasons behind her killing, but we understand she was murdered by suspected assailants over a business deal that is not too clear to us.

"We are not happy with the way she was killed as they [hoodlums] cut off her nipples," the source said, adding that the remains of the deceased had been deposited at the morgue by the Amotekun officials who visited the scene of the incident.

The state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Funmi Odunlami, confirmed the killing.

She, however, said there was no official report of the incident at any police station, adding that men of the Amotekun Corps intervened in the case.
