

Four killed in Ondo auto crash

FOUR persons on Wednesday lost their lives in an auto crash at Opa community, on the Ondo/Akure highway in Akure South Local Government Area of Ondo State

The sector commander of the Federal Road Safety

Corps (FRSC) in the state, Mr Ezekiel Sonallah, who confirmed the incident, attributed it to overspeeding.

The FRSC boss said the adults, accident, which occurred at about 5:00p.m., involved a "Three one molla car and a green Nissan crash."

Almera car which was head-

ing to Ondo City from Akure.

He said: "The number of people involved in the accident is 11 -- four male adults, five female adults and two male children.

"Three female adults and one male adult died in the crash."

Sonallah said the injured

victims had been taken to the University of Medical Sciences Teaching Hospital, Ondo, while the remains of the deceased had been deposited at the morgue.

He further said that the victims' belongings had been handed over to the police.
