FCT PDP chairman, two others die in fatal auto crash hours before election

Labour Party chairman dies in his sleep

THE Federal Capital Territory State chairman of the Peoples Democratic Party (PDP), Sunday Zakka, alongside his orderly and driver have died in an autocrash.

Secretary of the party in the state, Bako Angulu, confirmed the death to newsmen in the early hours of Saturday.

He said Zakka, his orderly and driver died in a motor accident off Nnamdi Azikiwe Airport- Kuje Road, Abuja, on Friday's night.

In his condolence message, the FCT Chairman of the All Progressives Congress (APC) Alhaji Abdul-

Malik Usman, described the demise of Mr Zakka as a great loss, adding that the late PDP Chairman was his personal friend and colleague.

In another development, the Labour Party (LP) chairman in Karshi district of the Federal Capital Territory (FCT), Valentine Onuigbo, has died in his sleep. Sunday Tribune learnt that the party chieftain co-ordinated the pre-election activities of the party till Friday night and was said to have been awaiting the commencement of voting on Saturday.

His body has now been deposited in Asokoro Hospital mortuary in Abuja.
