

Political party supporter shot dead in Ondo

A prominent supporter of a political party in Idanre Local Government Area of Ondo State, Akinlabi Akinnaso, known as Oluomo, has been shot dead allegedly by security operatives.

Oluomo was said to have lost his life in the early hours of Sunday at the Independent National Electoral Commission (INEC) collation centre at the headquarters of Idanre Local Government Area in

A source told the *Nigerian Tribune* that the deceased, who visited the collation centre on Sunday morning for the result of last Saturday's House of Representatives election, was said to have been ordered out of the council by security operatives at the collation centre.

He was said to be anxious to receive the announcement of the results and began putting pressure on officials, while the secu-

rity operatives warned him against disturbing the collating officials.

According to a source, Oluomo allegedly told the security operatives not to allow the officials tamper with the results, which led to a confrontation between him and the security men, who ordered him out of the premises.

The deceased was said to have refused to leave the premises and was shot in the process.
