Police arrest 16 suspected ritualists with 10 human skulls, 11 others in Oyo

HE police in Oyo State have confirmed the arrest of 16 suspected ritualists with nine fresh, dry human skulls and other vital body organs at Orita Aperin area in Ona-Ara Local Government Area.

Also, 11 other suspects, including kidnappers, armed robbers and cultists, were also nabbed.

Parading the suspects before newsmen in Ibadan on Thursday, the Commissioner

of Police in the state, Ade- in Ibadan metropolis. bowale Williams, through the state Police Public Re-Tations Officer (PPRO), Adewale Osifeso, disclosed that the suspects were arrested at different locations in the state.

He said the suspected ritualists specialised in selling of human skulls and other vital body organs to prospective buyers within and outside the state

The suspects, according to the police, were picked up from their hideout following a tip-off at Orita Aperin area

The report by the police reads: "On February 22, a discreet intelligence gathof policemen attached to the command's Monitoring Unit, uncovered the criminal activities of some hoodlums who specialised in selling human skulls and other vital Ibadan.
