Car crushes father, teenage daughter in Kwara

claimed the lives of a father and his teenage daughter along Jimba Oja, Idofian in Ifelodun Local Government Area of Kwara State.

The deceased were traveling on a Bajaj motorcycle, also known as okada, when they were hit by a Toyota Camry car which was on high speed.

It was gathered that the incident led to protest by residents of the community who vented their anger over frequent accidents in the area.

When contacted, the sec-

tor commander of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) in the state, Frederick Ade Ogidan, confirmed the incident.

He said the two occupants in the Toyota Camry car were injured while the man and his teenage daughter on the motorcycle were later confirmed dead at the University of Ilorin Teaching Hospital (UITH).

"The command is looking at putting some rumbling stripes on the road to reduce speed because bumps would worsen the situation.

"We have succeeded in calming the protest," Ogidan said.
