

Bandits invade Kaduna community, kill pastor's son, kidnap wife, three others

BANDITS, in the early hours of Friday morning, attacked a pastor's house at Karimbu-Kahugu community in Lere Local Government Area of Kaduna State.

It was gathered that during the attack, the hoodlums killed the cleric's son and abducted his wife and three other persons.

Confirming the attack to newsmen, the vice chairman of the Kahugu National Development Association, Peter Mukaddas, said the bandits invaded the community and went straight to the pastor's house.

"In the process, they killed his son for refusing to be kidnapped. However, his wife and three others who were in the house during the invasion were abducted.

"We are calling on the state government to intervene and ensure they return safely to their homes.

"We are fervently praying to God to touch their (the hoodlums') hearts so that they can see the wisdom to release them," Mukaddas said.

As of the time of filing the report, the community leader said the bandits had not made any contact with the family or made any ransom demand.
