

3 shot dead in Delta, 1 killed in Cross River

ablaze in Mosogar, Ethiope

Speaking with Sunday
Tribune about his ordeal,
a chieftain of the All Pro-
gressives Congress (APC),
Dr Wilson Omene, whose
house was set ablaze, said
his home was attacked by

machete and gun-wielding
hoodlums in about four ve-
hicles while he was trying
to cast his vote.

In a related develop-
ment, a suspected political
thug was said to have been
shot dead at a polling unit
in Ogoja, Cross River State.

The Commissioner of Po-

lice in the state, Mr Garba
Aliyu, in a telephone con-
versation, said a man sus-
pected to be a thug was
gunned down by soldiers,
adding that "I don't have
the full details yet."

Sunday Tribune also
gathered that the Peoples
Democratic Party (PDP)

in the state lost seven ve-
hicles to a fire incident
late Friday evening. An
eyewitness who spoke on
condition of anonymity
disclosed that the incident
took place at Okut-Ikang/
Akpap axis of Odukpani
Local Government Area of
the state.

According to the eye-
witness: "On Friday eve-
ning, seven PDP vehicles
including four buses and
three SUVs were burnt.
One woman was also shot
in the belly at Ikot Effiong
Otop. Some policemen
were disarmed and weap-
ons taken away."
