

## Three killed as cultists resume killings in Ogun

THREE persons have been shot dead by members of two rival cult groups in Ogun State in the last five days.

The killings were reported to have happened at Panseke and Araromi areas of Abe-

okuta. It was gathered that the renewed clashes were in commemoration of the one year remembrance of a popular area boy, identified as Tommy, who was killed on March 24, 2022.

During Friday's clash, a young man was said to have

been killed while returning from Computer Village at Ibara, while a stray bullet also hit a little child.

Another young man was also shot to death on Tuesday at Araromi area of Abeokuta.

The incidents were confirmed by the state Police Pub-

lic Relations Officer (PPRO), SP Abimbola Oyeyemi, with a promise that the command would arrest the situation.

The state capital was under siege between March and April last year as a result of activities of Eiye and Aiye cult groups.
