

How suspected cultist killed Ondo varsity final-year student over N1,000

MORE details have emerged on how a final-year student of Adekunle Ajasin University, Akungba-Akoko, Ondo State, Temitayo Ayodeji, was

It was gathered that Temitayo, a student of Physics/Electronics, who just wrote his final examination, was stabbed in his hostel at Ebenco area of Akungba-Akoko over a disagreement on N1000.

A source close to the late Temitope explained that the suspected cultist, who is an indigene of the town, stabbed the deceased over his refusal to part with N1000 demanded by the cultists.

He said all efforts to save Temitope failed, adding that the final-year student was

confirmed dead at a hospital in Iwaro-Akoko.

He explained that angry students mobilised and set the family house of one of the suspected assailants ablaze.

He said: "The student was rushed to a nearby hospital where he was pronounced

dead. His death angered other students who set the suspect's house ablaze."

The president of AAUA Students Union, Mr. Ogunsanmi Kolade, who described the killing of the man as "unfortunate", said efforts were ongoing to arrest the suspects, and added that the perpet-

rators would be made to face justice.

Ondo Police spokesperson, Funmilayo Odunlami, confirmed the incident and said efforts were ongoing to arrest the suspects and that police personnel had been deployed to maintain law and order in the town.
