A source close to the late confirmed dead at a hospital Temitope explained that the suspected cultist, who He explained that angry is an indigene of the town, stabbed the deceased over his refusal to part with N1000 the suspected assailants demanded by the cultists.

He said all efforts to save Temitope failed, adding that the final-year student was

in Iwaro-Akoko.

students mobilised and set the family house of one of ablaze.

He said: "The student was rushed to a nearby hospital where he was pronounced dead. His death angered other students who set the suspect's house ablaze."

The president of AAUA Students Union, Mr. Ogunsanmi Kolade, who described the killing of the man as "unfortunate", said efforts were ongoing to arrest the suspects, and added that the perpet-

rators would be made to face justice.

Ondo Police spokesperson, Funmilayo Odunlami, confirmed the incident and said efforts were ongoing to arrest the suspects and that police personnel had been deployed to maintain law and order in the town.
