

Gunmen kill two immigration officers, varsity lecturer in Taraba

GUNMEN on Wednesday ambushed and killed two immigration officers as well as a lecturer with the Federal University, Wukari, in Taraba State. The immigration officers,

identified as Inspectors Adike Austin and Uzo James, were said to have been attached to the Ussa council checkpoint.

According to police report, the officers were ambushed while returning from their duty post, with their bodies and motorcycle abandoned by the roadside.

The state Police Public Relations Officer, Usman Abdul-lahi, who confirmed the incident to the **Nigerian Tribune**,

disclosed that the bodies of the officers had been deposited at a morgue for autopsy.

He said full-scale investigation had already commenced, adding that the

killing was not related to the ongoing herders/farmers crisis in the area.

② Also, the lecturer, Daniel Bala, was killed on his farm.

It was later gathered that some youths later attacked and killed a man in a community close to where the incidents occurred.
