

# Five killed in Bauchi accident

AN accident involving an Astra Vectra commercial vehicle has claimed five lives in Bauchi State, with one person seriously injured.

A road traffic crash (RTC) report from RS 12.1, Bauchi sector command of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) indicated that the crash occurred on Monday, at about 7:05a.m.

The accident occurred at Tasahn Durumi, on the Bauchi-Jos highway.

According to the FRSC sector commander in the state,

Yusuf Abdullahi, speed limit violation (SPV) was the probable cause of the crash.

Six persons, comprising two male adults and four female adults were injured in the crash, while five (a male adult and four female adults) were killed.

The injured victim and the dead bodies were handed over to the officer in charge in of Tashan Durumi police outpost, Ahmed Usman.

The FRSC boss charged drivers to always maintain their vehicles in order to prevent accidents that will lead to avoidable loss of human lives.
