

FRSC confirms death of two in Bauchi multiple crashes

③ TWO people have been confirmed killed in multiple auto crashes that occurred at two different locations in Bauchi State.

The confirmation was made by the Bauchi State sector command of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), which also confirmed that 10 other victims were

injured.

According to the RS 12.12 Darazo/Zebra 45 in Darazo Local Government Area of the state, a road traffic crash (RTC) report indicated that the first crash occurred at about 11:46 a.m on Monday.

According to the FRSC, the accident involved an ash-coloured Volkswagen Sharan minibus used for commercial purposes.

The FRSC said the number of people involved in the accident were 10, comprising five male adults, four female adults and one female child, while one male adult died.

The probable cause of the accident, according to the FRSC, was tyre burst on motion.

The injured victims and the body of the deceased were evacuated to the General

Hospital, Darazo.

④ The second was reported from Zebra 30, Toro - Mag-aman Gumau in Toro LGA on Tuesday at 1:55p.m.

According to the FRSC, the accident occurred on the Toro-Bauchi highway at KM9 in Gada Biyu village.

The accident involved two vehicles, with one male adult killed, while another male adult was injured.
