Fire outbreaks killed 23, destroyed properties worth N29m in Kano in

THE Kano State Fire Service has said that in the month of April, a total of 23 lives were lost to fire outbreaks across the state, while properties worth N29, 090,000 were destroyed in the processes.

This is just as the agency said that the number of people saved from different fire disasters is 64.

Disclosing this on Tues-

day in a statement made to newsmen in Kano, the agency's Public Relation Officer, PFS Saminu Yusif Abdullahi, stated that the "estimated properties saved by our men is N73,195,000."

According to him, "the state's fire service received emergency calls from our twenty-seven 27 fire stations across the state in April."

He stated that 83 fire calls, 45 rescue calls and 3.9 false alarms were also received.
