

Tinubu's campaign council chairman killed in Imo

THE chairman of the Tinubu/Shettima Presidential Campaign Council Chairman in Oru -East Local Government Area of Imo State in the just concluded 2023 presidential election, Captain Enoch, has been shot dead by gunmen.

The deceased, who is from the same local government, was said to have been killed on Tuesday night around Awamama Technical School area while returning from an APC stakeholders meeting held at the local government headquarters and his body dumped in his car boot.

A community source revealed that the deceased was ambushed by armed men who ordered him to park his car before he was

shot dead and his body dumped in his car boot.

The source said, "The lifeless body of the deceased was found by passersby who saw traces of blood under a parked car and raised alarm which attracted the residents of the community.

"He appeared to have been killed by three gunshots to his head at the time his lifeless body was found on Tuesday night."

The spokesman of the Imo State police command, ASP Henry Okoye, confirmed the incident to the **Nigerian Tribune** on Thursday.

He said that the command has commenced investigation to unravel the circumstances surrounding the killing.

He assured that the perpetrators of the heinous crime would be brought to book.
