IPOB sit-at-home: One killed in Imo as residents desert roads

SUSPECTED gunmen have killed one Mr. Philip, an indigene of Agwa community in Oguta local government area of Imo State.

The deceased according to eye witnesses, was shot dead along Ogbaku/Ejemekuru road between the hours of 3 and 4pm on Monday.
