IPOB sit-at-home: One killed in Imo as residents desert roads

SUSPECTED gunmen have
killed one Mr. Philip, an indi-
gene of Agwa community in
Oguta local government area
of Imo State.

The deceased according to
eye witnesses, was shot dead
along Ogbaku/Ejemekuru
road between the hours of 3
and 4pm on Monday.

This is as the Indigenous
People of Biafra (IPOB) de-
clared a sit-at-home order

in Igbo lands on Tuesday in
commemoration of the extra-
judicial killings of some inno-
cent Igbo sons and daughters
by alleged security forces.

The killing of Philip is coming
in less than one week after a
notable traditional ruler of Ezi-

orsu Community in Oguta LGA
was gunned down by yet to be
identified hoodlums.

The situation provoked
fresh fears among residents
in the area which has necessi-
tated in some of them fleeing
their homes.
