

# Police kill notorious armed robber, Wordi Amadi, three others terrorising East-West Road

**R**IVERS State police command on Tuesday announced the killing of one Wordi Amadi and three of his notorious kidnap gang members accused of terrorising the Emohua axis of the East-West Road in Rivers State.

The gang, according to the Rivers State Commissioner of Police, Nwonyi Polycarp, the gang members were killed somewhere at Ogoloma, in Okirika Local Government Area of the state during an exchange of gunfire with police operatives.

The police boss explained that members of the gang on sighting the police opened fire but were overpowered

due to the superior fire power of the police operatives.

He said: "Wordi Amadi and his gang had been on the wanted list of the police. He had killed policemen, innocent citizens, and had been terrorising the East-West Road, kidnapping and robbing for ransom.

"He had made Elibrada indigenes desert their homes.

"The gang leader, named Wordi Amadi, and three of his gang members, including a female, were fatally wounded.

"They were quickly rushed to the University of Port Harcourt Teaching Hospital for treatment, but on arrival, the doctor on duty confirmed they had died."

Some of the exhibits recovered from the suspects include one AK-47 rifle with 25

rounds of 7.62 x 32mm, one assault rifle with 20 rounds of live ammunition, one pump-action rifle with four live cartridges and assorted charms.

The chairman of Emohua Local Government Area, Mr Chidi Lloyd, had placed a bounty of N1 million on Amadi, an amount he recently increased to N2 million.
