

## Three Imo APC members going for NASS inauguration killed in auto crash

Progressives Congress (APC) from Imo State on Monday lost their lives while travelling to Abuja for the inauguration of the 10th National Assembly scheduled for Tuesday.

The accident occurred after the bus they were travelling in

had a head-on collision with another bus at Agbor in Delta State.

Nigerian Tribune learnt that three persons in the bus were confirmed dead, while others who sustained various degrees of injury were rushed to hospitals around the area.

Two males from Amaraku community in Isiala Mbano Local Government Area of the

state and a female from Ogbor community in the same Isiala Mbano LGA died in the accident.

A chieftain of the party who did not want to be mentioned said the victims were coordinators for the senator-elect for Imo North, Patrick Ndubueze, and House of Representatives member-elect for Okigwe North Federal Constituency,

Mirriam Onuoha.

He said: "Three persons died while others who sustained injuries were rushed to hospitals.

"Their bus had a head-on collision with another bus and the three persons – two males and a female died."

Spokesperson for the APC in the state, Cajetan Duke, confirmed the incident.
