Suspected robbers invade Imo communities, kill three

GUNMEN suspected to be robbers on Tuesday invaded some communities in Imo State, where they reportedly killed three persons.

Nigerian Tribune

gathered that while two persons were killed at Orogwe community in Owerri West Local Government Area, one other person was killed at Ndegwu community also in the same council area.

An eyewitness, however, said the attackers were likely to be armed robbers. It will be recalled that on Monday, during the sit-at-home compliance, some gunmen invaded the same community and snatched

a vehicle belonging to a former psychiatric director in the state.

While speaking, the state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Henry Okoye, said he was yet to receive an official report on the incident.
