

LASU student, five others killed in Ogun auto crashes

1 A 26-year-old student of Lagos State University (LASU), Ademola Timothy and five others were on Tuesday, killed in separate auto crashes in Ogun State.

According to the state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Omolola Odutola, the accident occurred at about 6:45a.m, before Babcock University junction, on the Sagamu-Benin expressway.

It involved a Geon truck, a Toyota Sienna vehicle and a Lexus car.

It was gathered that the driver of the Lexus car rammed a moving truck and

somersaulted on several occasions, while the Toyota Sienna vehicle hit the Lexus.

The victims were taken to Babcock University Teaching Hospital where they were pronounced dead by doctors on duty.

2 In the other crash, the Public Education Officer of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) in Ogun State, Florence Okpe, in a statement, said three passengers lost their lives when a truck with no number plate crushed them on the Ogi-jo-Mosimi road in Sagamu Local Government Area of Ogun State.

Okpe said the accident occurred at about 10:25p.m., adding that the truck rammed a tricycle.
