

One out of six Osun abducted victims dies in kidnappers' den, four regains freedom

ONE out of the six persons abducted by gunmen last week at Aworo village via Agbamu in Kwara State while returning from a trip to their hometown in Oyan in Odo-Otin Local Government Area of Osun State has been killed by the hoodlums, while four others regained their freedom after their family members reportedly paid a ransom of N7 million.

However, three suspected accomplices who served as abductors' informants are currently in police custody after being apprehended in

the kidnappers' den.

Speaking on the development, spokesperson for the Osun State Command of the Nigeria Security and Civil Defence Corps (NSCDC), Kehinde Adeleke, confirmed the release of the four abductees and the death of one person.

She also confirmed the arrest of three persons in connection with the crime.

It was gathered that those who regained their freedom were set free on Sunday after the ransom was paid, while the circumstance that led to the death of one of them could not be ascertained.
