

Ritual killing: Bauchi gov orders closure of school where body of boy was recovered

BAUCHI State governor, Senator Bala Mohammed, has ordered the immediate closure of the school where the body of a young boy, Mohammed Abidin Musa, was recovered.

The governor gave the order on Tuesday evening when he paid a condolence visit to the family of the boy.

Senator Mohammad described the killing by yet-to-be identified person(s) as shocking.

Musa was recently found dead in a school at the Games Village, with some of his vital organs removed.

The governor, accompanied by the Commissioner of Police, Awal Musa Mohamed, said the school would remain closed in order to hasten investigation into the crime.

The police boss had earlier urged people to always report suspicious movements of unknown persons in their areas to the police.
