

One killed as truck loaded with flour falls on Otedola bridge

ONE person was killed on the Otedola Bridge on Tuesday in an accident involving a truck loaded with flour.

The deceased is said to be the 'motor boy' of the truck driver.

The accident resulted in gridlock inward Lagos/Ibadan expressway and Ojodu Berger.

The flood also compounded the traffic challenges.

However, the Lagos State Traffic Management Authority (LAMATA) acknowledged the situation and assured the public that

efforts are underway to address it.

In a statement posted on its official social media handle, LASTMA said: "A fatal accident involving an upturned loaded (wheat) truck that has taken a lane on Otedola bridge inwards Ojodu Berger.

"Traffic is a bit slow coupled with the flooded portion on the bridge. Effort is on for the recovery of the contents and the truck from the road.
