

Four killed in Lagos-Ibadan expressway auto crash

FOUR persons, all male adults, in the early hours of Monday, lost their lives in an auto crash at Kara turning on the Lagos-Ibadan expressway.

The accident was reported to have involved two vehi-

cles.

Nigerian Tribune learnt that the accident occurred at about 12:45a.m.

Twenty one people were said to be involved in the accident, which included 13 male adults and eight female adults.

Three persons, one male

and two female adults, were injured, while four male adults died in the accident.

Excessive speeding, which led to loss of control, was attributed to be the suspected cause of the accident.

The Ogun State sector commander of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), Anthony

Uga, described the accident as one that could be avoided if necessary caution was put in place and simple rules obeyed.

He advised drivers to apply common sense on speed limit, especially at night when visibility is always poor.
