

Suspected herders kill three in Benue

SUSPECTED armed herdsmen on Saturday killed three persons at Imatom village in Logo Local Government Area of Benue State.

A community leader in the state, Joseph Anawa, disclosed this to newsmen on Sunday.

He identified the victims as Tertsea Terkimbi Adagundu, Tertsea Mkposu and Mimidoo Umburga.

According to him, "Their corpses have been deposited

at NKST Hospital morgue, Anyiin."

He claimed that the renewed attacks are aimed at displacing farmers in order to pave way for cattle to graze on their crops which are yet to be harvested.

Meanwhile, the state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Catherine Anene, said in a terse message that she didn't have information about the attack.

She said: "I don't have that information."
