

Two die in Kwara lone accident

TWO persons, a sugarcane vendor and a yet-to-be identified military officer were on Sunday crushed to death

in a lone auto accident in Kwara State.

Nigerian Tribune gathered that the incident happened at one of the checkpoints in Moro Local Government

Area of the state.

One of the eyewitnesses said a DAF articulated truck, which lost control, veered off the road before crushing four victims.

The source added that two of the victims died while the others only sustained varying degrees of injuries.

The sector commander

of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) in Kwara State, Frederick Ade Ogidan, confirmed the accident to journalists.

He stated: "It was a lone

accident involving a DAF truck which lost control and hit the victims. They were all males, but two of them died while the other two sustained injury."
