Two killed as fire guts Canadian Embassy in Abuja

·Tinubu promises support for victims

PHE Federal Cap-Territory Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), on Monday confirmed that a diesel tank explosion was responsible for the fire that gutted High Commission in Abuja, killing two persons and iniuring two others.

embassy for refuge outside the gates informed the Niaerian Tribune that fire fighting trucks moved in to put out the flames while rescue operations were intensified.

Meanwhile, President Bola Tinubu has sympathised with the Canadian diplomatic government, community, and all persons affected by a fire incident.
