

## 2 killed, 10 injured in Lagos-Ibadan road accident

TWO persons died on Friday morning in a crash that occurred, at the Kara turning of the inward section of the Lagos-Ibadan expressway.

**Saturday Tribune** learnt that 10 others were seri-

ously injured in the accident that involved a white colour XV 945 EPE and an unregistered white and blue colour Howo Sino Truck.

The suspected causes of the crash were route violation and dangerous driving.

The injured victims had been taken to a private

hospital and the dead bodies were deposited at a mortuary in Sagamu.

The Sector Commander, Federal Road Safety Corps, Commander Anthony Uga, while admonishing the motoring public advised that drivers should shun all forms of driving against traffic (one way) and ex-

press caution while driving in order to avoid endangering their lives and the lives of other road users.
