informant, the informant agreed to take the vigilantes to the bandits' hideout in the forest where a gun battle ensued.

"Security reports we received from the Makurdi ward, Ngaski local Government Area by our

vigilantes led to the arrest of an informant who promised to take our men to the kidnappers' hideout."

He narrated that the local vigilantes spent the night until morning between the hours of 3:30am – 4:30am when they successfully overpowered the criminals as a result of exchange of gunfire and killed the three of them.

The vigilantes, according to the press statement made available to newsmen, came back home safely without any casualty.

AbdulRahman commended the gallant efforts of the local vigilantes, who according to him, have been complimenting the efforts of other security operatives in combating the menace of bandits in the LGAs.
