Police arrest three suspected cultists in Sagamu after clash claims three

THREE suspected cultists have been arrested by the men of the Ogun State police command in connection with the cult clash that occurred in Sagamu area of the state.

The state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Omolola Odutola, in a statement, said a group of men suspected to be cultists had caused trouble at Agbowa area of the town.

The statement reads: "Upon receiving the information, the divisional police officer swiftly led a patrol team

to the area. On arrival, they discovered three unidentified young men lying lifeless in a pool of blood with gunshot wounds to their heads.

"The victims were immediately rushed to Olabisi Onabanjo Teaching Hospital in Sagamu, where a doctor certified them dead. Their bodies were subsequently taken to the morgue.

"Cordoning off the scene of crime, eight expended cartridges, one live cartridge and one Samsung phone were recovered in connection with the cult clash, three individuals have been arrested."
