

Two children die in New Year day accident on Lagos-Ibadan expressway

TWO children died in a lone accident involving a Toyota car on New Year day at Ade Best axis, Isara, on the Lagos-Ibadan expressway.

According to the News Agency of Nigeria (NAN), spokesperson for the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) in

Ogun State, Mrs Florence Okpe, confirmed the incident to newsmen in Abeokuta on Monday.

Okpe said the incident occurred at 8:00a.m. and was caused by speeding and loss of control, adding that the car ran into a ditch.

She said five persons were involved in the accident, which comprised three children, a man and a woman, with two persons dead and three others injured.

The suspected cause of the lone crash was excessive speed and the vehicle sud-

denly lost control and ran into a ditch.

"The injured victims were taken to Victory Hospital, Ogere for medical attention, while the deceased corpses were deposited at Isara General Hospital morgue," she said.
