"Furthermore, the sector commander has directed full investigation into the crash, which has already commenced."

In the other accident, Kaduna sector command of the FRSC said six persons died and 11 injured in the crash on the Kaduna-Zaria expressway.

The sector commander, Mr Kabir Nadabo, told the News Agency of Nigeria (NAN) in Kaduna that the accident occurred at Aliko fuel station on the Kaduna-Zaria expressway at about

6:25a.m on Tuesday.

Nadabo said the accident was caused by speeding and dangerous driving.

"The initial investigation of the crash revealed that 23 people were involved; 11 were injured and six lost their lives," Nadabo said.

He said the Toyota bus was coming from Ilesha and heading to Batsari, in Katsina State when the accident occurred.

The FRSC boss said: "The driver, who was on high speed, lost control and rammed a moving vehicle."
