One dies, 3 injured as trailer rams into passengers on Lagos-Abeokuta expressway

THE Ogun State Traffic Compliance and Enforcement Corps (TRACEC) has said an articulated vehicle crushed a man to death leaving three others injured on the Lagos-Abeokuta express-way.

Mr Adekunle Ajibade, South-West Area Commander of TRACEC, told the News Agency of Nigeria (NAN) in Ota on Saturday that the incident occurred at about 5.06 a.m at the tollgate.

Ajibade explained that the vehicle with registration no. XA356 ALD, coming from Sango-Ota to Lagos, lost control due to speeding and rammed into four persons waiting to board a bus at Toll Gate.

He added that the incident resulted in the death of a man while three others sustained varying degrees of injuries.

"The corpse of the vic-

tim has been deposited at the morgue in Ifo General Hospital, Ota, while the survivors are receiving treatment at the same hospital," he said.

Ajibade cautioned motorists, especially truck drivers, against speeding to prevent avoidable crashes.
