Troops kill three bandits, recover weapons in Taraba

IROOPS of the 6 Brigade, Nigerian Army deployed in Karim-Lamido Local Government Area of Taraba State on Thursday stormed a bandits' camp, killed three hoodlums and recovered weapons and ammunition.

The brigade commander, Brigadier-General Kingsley Uwa, disclosed this while explaining the victory against the criminals in the state.

Uwa said the operation took place at Chibi village, where the 6 Brigade troops,

acting on actionable intelligence, conducted a precision strike against the criminals.
