

Four killed in lone accident on Lagos-Ibadan expressway

FOUR person were killed in a lone accident that occurred in the early hours of Tuesday around Sandcrate area on the Lagos-Ibadan expressway.

The accident occurred at about 5:57a.m. with 20 persons onboard the *Toyota* bus.

According to a statement by the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) Public Education Officer, Florence Okpe, 10 male persons were injured, while four male adults

were recorded dead.

Excessive speed was reported to be the cause of the accident, as the vehicle somersaulted several times.

The sector commander of the FRSC in Ogun State, Anthony Uga, urged drivers to always maintain the required speed limit while driving on the highway.

The FRSC boss advised drivers to always check their tyres before embarking on journeys and also avoid use of worn-out tyres.
