Nine killed in Lagos-Abeokuta expressway accident

INE persons, comprising five male and four female adults, were killed in an accident that occurred at about

8:00a.m. on Tuesday on the Lagos-Abeokuta expressway.

According to the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) Public Education Officer, Florence Okpe, the accident involved a truck and a Mazda bus.

It was gathered that the

accident, which occurred at Kere Bridge, was as a result of excessive speed and driving against traffic.

A total of 17 people were reported to have been involved in the crash, with nine killed and seven injured.

The state sector com-

mander of the FRSC, Anthony Uga, cautioned motorists on route violation and excessive speed.

He pointed out the dangers associated with the two offences, while advising motorists to adhere to traffic rules and regulations.
