

Hoodlums kill 27-year-old in Ogun

SUSPECTED hoodlums on Monday murdered a 27-year-old man identified as Toriola Tobi, in Abeokuta, the Ogun State capital.

***Nigerian Tribune* gathered that the victim was attacked and killed by the hoodlums**

following a scuffle between him and yet-to-be identified persons.

The incident, according to an eyewitness, occurred at about 7:00p.m., when the deceased was said to be walking alone along a secluded street in Isokan Estate, behind Premier Grammar School area of the town.

The incident was reported at the Ilupeju divisional police headquarters, in Sabo for further investigation into circumstances surrounding the crime.

The identities of those behind the crime were still unknown, while full investigation has commenced on the directive of the state Com-

missioner of Police, Abiodun Alamutu.

The police boss directed every intelligence be deployed to ensure the fleeing suspects are apprehended.

The CP called for cooperation of members of the public to volunteer credible information that can expose those behind the killing.
