Another five killed on Lagos/Ibadan expressway

AGAIN, five persons were killed on Thursday around Fidiwo bridge, on the Lagos-Ibadan expressway following wrongful overtaking and excessive speed.

The Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), Public Education Officer for the Ogun State command, Florence Okpe, in a statement, said the accident occurred at about 2:48p.m.

She said the crash involved nine persons, including six fe-

males and three male adults.

According to her, three females and two males lost their lives in the crash which involved two vehicles, a Prime bus and a Toyota Camry.

She said those injured were taken to a private hospital for treatment, while the bodies of

the deceased were deposited at a morgue in Ipara-Remo.

The FRSC sector commander, Anthony Uga, charged motorists to observe the speed limit on the highway.

An accident on Wednesday had previously claimed five lives on the expressway.
