

Gunmen kill technician in Ogun community

A middle-aged technician, Kazeem Akinsipo, has been killed by gunmen around Oba TT Dada Street in Ota area of Ado Odo / Ota Local Government Area of Ogun State.

The killing of Kazeem occurred few weeks after

suspected cultists killed someone at a brothel on the same street.

The deceased Kazeem had just returned home when two armed men attacked him and went away with his motorcycle.

The hoodlums shot Kazeem in the stomach and also hacked his head and other

parts of the body with machetes.

A resident of the area who pleaded anonymity told the Nigerian Tribune that "he [Kazeem] was attacked on Tuesday night but he died this morning [Wednesday]."

"He came to see his wife and they were sitting outside

when the two gunmen came and demanded the key of his motorcycle.

"They then shot him in the stomach and also used a machete to inflict wounds on his head."

Another resident who identified himself as Waheed said, "Kazeem was relaxing

with some of his friends at nearby Akinbo Street when he was called to come home.

"When he got home, he parked his motorcycle in front of the house and sat outside with his wife when the hoodlums went to where he was.

"After the attack, he was taken to some hospitals in the

area but they rejected him, instead directing that he should be taken to the General Hospital."

When contacted, the state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Omolola Odutola, said the police were yet to get any report of the incident as of Wednesday evening.
