

Three killed in Adamawa communal clashes

THREE persons have been confirmed killed in communal clashes in Adamawa State.

The state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Suleiman Yahaya Ngoroje, made this known in a statement he made available to

newsmen on Wednesday.

The police spokesperson said three persons lost their lives during a communal violence in Numan and Demsa local government areas.

He said: "The violence claimed three lives at Selti and Kpasham communities in Numan and Demsa council

areas."

He added that "as of today [Wednesday], normalcy has returned to the communities."

Ngoroje said the Commissioner of Police, Dankombo Morris, personally led operatives to the areas and assessed the situation on ground, adding that investigation is still ongoing to ap-

prehend perpetrators of the violence.

"The CP enjoins residents to shun violence and peacefully go about their lawful activities without any fear.

"He urges the public to report people of questionable characters to the nearest police stations," the police spokesperson said.
